

Revelation of the Name

When asked by Moses, God revealed His personal sacred name as being YHWH. These four letters are called the sacred tetragrammaton and represent the omission of the vowel points of the word. The Hebrew word is generally translated “to be” or “I am” and is pronounced Yahweh or Yahveh. When the Angel Gabriel came to Miriam (Mary) to tell her of her conception, he told her that the name of the child would be “Yahweh is Salvation” or in the Hebrew “Yahshua”. This Hebrew child was naturally to have a Hebrew name. The “J” sound and spelling that has been imposed on scripture by the English translations does not have a counterpart in either the Greek or the Hebrew. If we want to have a personal relationship with God (Messiah), it is important that we know and utilize His personal name. The spelling of His name is not so important as the usage.
